2015/31 **County Borough Council**

Cllr. Fitzpatrick reported that there is a debate next Thursday regarding the Government White Paper. There is concern among community councils as the government would like to merge community councils and only keep those with budgets over £200,000.00. They also want to cut down on the number of councillors. Powys cannot be broken up as it is too big and it would take the merger of lots of councils to attain budgets of £200,00.00

Cllr. Keylock proposed that this community council meet informally 3 times per year with other community councils in this area to work on specific issues.

Flooding Llanspyddid - Cllr. Fitzpatrick has contacted Simon Crowther as nothing has been done to address this issue for over a year. Cllr. Hill ask for a date of when the survey is going to be done. Cllr. Fitzpatrick will speak to the cabinet member John Brunt.

Speed limits Llanspyddid/bus shelter - The bus shelter has still not been rebuilt as there is no money at present. The debris needs clearing away. Cllr. Fitzpatrick will speak to the cabinet member. Kirsty Williams A.M. was going to ask the Assembly why it will take 3 - 4 years to implement the speed limit.
