**2015/45****Defibrillators**

It is now becoming common to have defibrillators in rural areas as they are essential for saving lives. There are 2 types of machine in operation and both work in the same way, the IPAD machine costs £9f0.00 and the ZOL AD £1150.00. The British Heart Foundation have a scheme where a machine can be bought for a donation of £400.00, but will take up to 3 months to obtain. A cabinet will also have to be bought and these can cost almost as much as the machines. The ambulance service will provide batteries for the ZOL machine and the battery for the IPAD is £130.00. It was suggested that the phone box could be used to store the machine. Mr Powell offered to be the training supervisor should the community council decide to buy a machine. Mr Powell then left the meeting.

After discussion it was agreed that the issue should be surveyed amongst residents as the machines and cabinets are so expensive. It could be put on the website. Cllr. Hill will mention it in the next Llanspyddid meeting and report back at the next community council meeting.
