It was resolved that the following complaints be passed on to Councillor Fitzpatrick for his attention.

- a. Flooding in Llanspyddid – Cllr. Hill has not yet sent the letter.
- b. Llanspyddid bus shelter – Cllr. Fitzpatrick to bring it up with the cabinet member this week. It was suggested writing to the local newspaper but statistics are needed.
- c. Rubbish collections will now be every 4 weeks.
- d. Powys will be discussing the next 3 years budget as there are problems with elderly social care.
- e. There are still issues with the new recycling centre, Llanfrynach community council will also be complaining.
