2015/77 **County Borough Council**

It was resolved that the following complaints be passed on to Councillor Fitzpatrick for his attention.

- a. Flooding in Llanspyddid – Cllr. Hill has sent a letter to Chris Davies M.P. and Kirsty Williams A.M. who have sent it on to Powys CC. Cllr. Hill met Chris Davies recently and is hoping to get together with him soon as he is unaware of the flooding issues. Cllr. Fitzpatrick will speak to the cabinet member John Brunt tomorrow.
- b. Llanspyddid bus shelter – an email has been received from John Forsey regarding the costs of replacing the shelter and it was mentioned about GTCC taking over the maintenance of it but this has never been discussed or agreed by the community council.
- c. Rubbish collections every 3 weeks – many residents are not happy with this and the recycling centre is not fit for purpose. There could be an increase in fly tipping.
- d. There have been 2 seminars recently regarding the budget. Social care and education seem to be okay but highways have been badly hit.
