

to save £40,000.00 . He said that he is trying to work with community councils to keep the work local. He reported that he has a contract to cut a playing field in Libanus, they cut the bank but the community council pay for the field to be cut. Cllr. Keylock will find out which area Powys are cutting as they also cut a hedge in the area.

Mr Butcher said that LLanspyddid should have 12 cuts per year but the wild area should be cut by the community council. Cllr. Hill said that Powys CC did not cut LLanspyddid last year, it was cut by the residents.

Mr Butcher said that he would be talking to smaller contractors and possible giving money to community councils to cover contracts. Grounds maintenance will be outsourced in 2017 and discussed on an annual basis. Cllr Fitzpatrick how will private companies be held to account.
