Cllr. Fitzpatrick reported that during the new Welsh lockdown in 2 weeks only emergency services will be attended to. 85% of Powys CC staff are working from home. There is compensation available for some businesses.

Cllr. Fitzpatrick said that if any councillors know of any resident who may be struggling to get medicines etc. he can arrange help. He also said that any resident having to travel out of the area should give their registration number to the police.

Cllr. Harris asked what the law on cyclists during lockdown periods as there have been a lot of them travelling over the Beacons. Cllr. Fitzpatrick said it was the same law and was being policed by BBNP wardens

Cllr. Hill declared an interest and left the meeting as she is a member of the Friends of Llanspyddid. Glyn Tarell Community Council will hold the lease and approve up to 12 events per year for Llanspyddid. The lease will be renewed annually. The Licensee will cover the cost of grass cutting. The Licensor is the Church in Wales. Both parties will have public liability insurance of 5 million. Cllr. Baker proposed that the community council hold the lease, Cllr. Harris seconded. Cllr Hill then re-joined the meeting and agreed to check the field weekly.
