**2026/13** **Minutes**

**2026/15** **County Borough Council**

Cllr. Devlin reported on the budget. The Poverty Local fund was donated to the following, Libanus YFC £2,500.00, Friends of Llanspyddid £1,500.00 and Talybont Community Council £1,000.00

Cllr. Woods asked about the crash barrier work on the A40, it's to reduce speed limit to 50 m.p.h.

Powys CC Housing Dept. have agreed to surface the path in Libanus Playground

- e. Llanilltyd's Churchyard – the tree surgery has been completed. The fencing will

commence on 23<sup>rd</sup> February. Cllr. Hill has ordered bat and bird boxes. There is lots of wood left there. It will be cleared up by the Councillors.

- f. URC Church – things are making progress. An email from the solicitor stated that nothing showed up on the searches. The retaining wall is the responsibility of the Trunk Road Agency. A meeting is needed to locate the septic tank and regarding contents of the church. Cllr. Woods will arrange a meeting with local funeral directors regarding the burial ground.
  
- g. Llanspyddid Church – a meeting of the Friends of Llanspyddid was held recently. £8,000.00 was quoted for the upkeep in 2018 which will possibly cost more now. There is no running water or toilet there. A possible partnership was suggested. There is still a ‘For Sale’ notice up but it is not on the website.
