- l. Mr C Smith Countryside Manager of the National Trust attended the meeting' He spoke about Ty Mawr as the tenant farmer has now left. They are now creating an education centre there and hope to work closely with the community. The cattle shed has now become a tree nursery but are struggling to get good trees at present. They hope to plant 1 million trees by 2030. Mr Smith is happy to arrange a tour around Ty Mawr. Cllr. Woods asked if the Community Council could help with volunteers there - yes

They are building dams on the Beacons but this should not affect graziers.
The estimate for visitors to Pen Y Fan is 750,000.00, there were 390,000.00 in 2023
He was asked who controls events at Storey Arms, they ask permission from the land owners i.e. National Trust and graziers. BBNPA charge £1.00 per person for permission.
The Community Council are concerned about the number of events held and the parking situation. Dog mess and wild camping is an ongoing issue there.

Pont yr Daf Plantation – the non- native trees need removing. They have a 30 year plan for this area.

The Community Council thanked Mr Smith for attending the meeting, he said he will try to attend every quarter if possible.
