**2024/61** **Matters Arising**

- a. The fence behind the Tai'r Bull is falling over – a BBNPA warden has checked the fence and reported that the path is clear of obstructions but the fence that they made temporary repairs to on the proviso that the manager of the Tai's Bull would arrange to have fully repaired has not been done and they have not been able to contact him.

- d. Cllr. Murphy letter to the police regarding the speed of vehicles passing – reply from Dyfed Powys Police. They are aware of the road and regularly patrol especially during Summer months and weekends and regularly carry out checks. In relation to speed this needs to be addressed with Go Safe (there was a Go Safe van at the reservoir this evening) Our complaint has been passed on to be reviewed with the Neighbourhood Policing Team For review.
- e. The gate needs adjusting on the cattle grid at the BBNPA Visitor Centre – nothing to report
- f. Llanspyddid church field culvert – Cllr. Hill has had a quote for £385.00. Cllr. Woods

proposed that it be accepted, seconded by Cllr. Harris

- g. Phone box Libanus – Cllr. Murphy was not present
- h. Llanilltyd's Churchyard – the reply from the Church in Wales states that the burial ground was transferred to the Parish Council of Glyn on 21<sup>st</sup> July 1925 and they will inform Land Registry. Cllr. Woods and Hill will inspect it for health & safety reasons. Cllr. Woods will approach a local valuer for a quote as it needs to be added to the asset register.
- i. ROSPA Report – work has been done. Cllr. Woods will have another look at the posts to see if they need protection from strimmers
- j. There are 2 trees across the Tarell – NRW may possible using them to slow the water flow down.
- k. There are potholes on the B4215 towards Defynnog – not done
- l. Libanus playground meeting – Cllr Hill and Woods spoke to 3 groups of residents, They would like the following,
  - No dogs allowed
  - Play equipment for older children e.g. climbing frame
  - Rugby posts are not used and can be taken down but they would like football nets
  - They were happy with the planting
  - Cllr Hill suggested bird boxes
  - Cllr. Woods suggested another meeting
